CALL FOR PAPERS - EXTENDED UNTIL JUNE 30

RAP invites you to share your research works and best practices that highlight the role of language and literacy in teaching and learning during and beyond these challenging times. Due to numerous requests, we are extending the deadline. We welcome submissions of research works and best practices across grade levels for oral and poster presentation, demonstration teaching, and symposium.

Submission Guidelines:

A. Abstract Submission

1. Must be between 200-300 words with no more than six keywords.
2. The abstract must contain the following: what was investigated - problem, participants, research design, methods, major conclusions, and implications to teaching.

B. Best Practices

1. Theoretical underpinning of the lesson which must not exceed 150 words (This presents the theoretical basis of the lesson - e.g., what theory /theories inform it; what makes it effective for the target learners; etc.)
2. Semi- detailed lesson plan which contains the following: title (preferably a catchy one and should reflect the strand and target participants); topic; objectives (affective and cognitive); and lesson proper (activities to be done e.g., prereading, during reading, and post-reading activities.)

C. Poster Submission

1. Research work submission must contain the following: title; introduction; brief literature review; methodology; results and discussions; conclusions and implications.
2. Best practices submission must contain the following: title; theoretical underpinning; and semi-detailed lesson.

D. Submission Format for Abstract and Best Practices:

1. Must indicate the type of presentation (oral, demonstration teaching, and symposium) and strand (primary grades, intermediate grades, secondary level, etc.)
2. Single-spaced with one-inch margin on all sides
3. Font type: Garamond or Times New Roman; Font : 10
4. Word file
5. Since the submissions are subjected to blind review, names or anything that will reveal the identity of the proponent/s should not be included.
6. The complete name, affiliation, contact details, title of submission, and strand should be submitted in a separate file to **rapgoldenjubilee@gmail.com** on or before **June 30, 2021** with the subject e-mail as **RAP2021_ Last Name_First Name**
7. Notification of acceptance is on **July 10, 2021**.
